• Discussion Items:

- Daniel received an unsolicited ad from Bear Trap Cremation Services with a description and
 questionnaire without pricing information. Noura's thought was related to FTC but is
 something to consider around solicitation when working on new rules. Chris mentioned that
 marketing has changed, and this is an example of it. Derek mentioned as long as it's not a
 misrepresentation, it's just a business practice.
- Noura attended the International Conference of Funeral Service Examining Boards at the end of February in Palm Springs, California. Noura will receive a copy of California's proposed rules regarding alkaline hydrolysis and NOR which will be helpful when writing our rules on it. She will be working on drafting new rules and will meet with the advisors to work on and discuss them. Larry asked about the delay if someone wanted to offer these services, Derek stated that there is one facility in Vermont who offers these services by working with a facility in Maine, which is the only facility for these services in New England.

Public Comment:

- Chris asked about course requirements. Cape Cod Community College is now working with CCV and allowing those enrolled in CCV to get in state tuition at Cape Cod, allowing them to have access to more funeral director centered classes without taking prerequisites. Derek and Chris discussed the grants available to these professionals. Chris wants us to think about creating a better program for the funeral director license.
