Director's Report Fiscal Year 2014

Director's Report

This will be my final report as Director of OPR. As I prepare to depart this office, I find it fitting to lend some historical perspective to this year's annual report.

From my first Director's Report nine years ago in 2005:

"I plan to focus much more in future months on the service aspect of OPR. I will continue to explore better ways to serve the public, including the 45,000 or so professionals we license. There are many exciting new technologies on the market which may allow us to do a better job for the public. Online applications, electronic scanning and storage of documents, and increasingly specialized licensing software may allow us to provide more services without increasing staff."

It has been a long, interesting journey since then. We are now at 60,000 licensees and have doubled the number of cases we receive each year. True to what I stated above, advancements in technology and creative management has allowed us to hold at 31 full time positions today compared to the 28 we had when I wrote my first Director's report. The 2005 number also does not take into account the several temporary positions we would bring in for months at a time to meet peak license renewal processing demands, prior to electronic licensing system. We no longer use temporary employees to staff up at renewal time. We are doing more than ever with approximately the same number of staff.

Online license renewals have been in place for more than five years now and we are excited to report an average 98% online renewal rate for 2014. This allows us to turn around licenses immediately, meeting all demands with existing staff. It also lets us cut down on printing and mailing costs while at the same time freeing up staff to take on other duties. We are moving ahead with online initial applications and expect to have this service available for many more professions by the end of 2015.

An excellent investigative unit with very little turnover has allowed us to keep investigation numbers at a manageable level for each investigator. As a result, the unit is able to turn each case around quickly in an average of 264 days from beginning to end for all unprofessional conduct complaints for FY15. We do this while still maintaining the quality we need to make the right decisions on allegations of such a serious nature.

We are tracking investigation times and overall case processing times and are pleased to see those numbers going ever downward. Over the last two years, more than 90% of our investigations were completed in 180 days or less.

We are now measuring initial application processing volume and times. As eLicense was implemented in 2009, processing times began to drop and continue to do so. The average days to process a new license application today is about half of what it was five years ago. It will be interesting to follow those numbers as more professions go to online applications and scanned and emailed responses become more commonplace. Application processing times will continue to shrink, allowing applicants to get their licenses and begin working in Vermont with very little wait time. This is both a public protection issue and an economic issue.

Easy digital storage of documents has become a reality and our staff are far less inundated with piles of paper or looming rows of file cabinets full of pending and completed applications. We have recently stopped sending any applications to the records center for storage and have all licensing documents stored digitally in our licensing system, attached to the individual applicant's digital record.

Through all of the changes, public protection has always been our priority. More efficient processing and resolution of cases means better public protection. It also respects licensees and complainants alike. Faster processing of applications gets qualified licenses to work. This frees up OPR staff to work on other initiatives for better customer service, board support and all around improvements to our public protection mission.

Good customer service has always been a goal and has been particularly emphasized under Secretary of State Jim Condos. I am especially thankful for his leadership and support on this and so many other issues, including the opportunity to become the next Deputy Secretary of State.

I look back and am thankful to have worked with the passionate and selfless individuals who are our board members and advisors. I am grateful to have been on a team with such a dedicated group of public servants in our OPR staff, and I wish them all continued success.






