11. Respondent is of sound mind and is not under the influence of drugs or alcohol when signing this Pre-Charge Stipulation and Consent Order.
12. Respondent agrees the Order set forth below may be entered, will be a binding Order upon Respondent, and will be public.
13. Respondent understands that Respondent is responsible for all compliance costs associated with this Pre-Charge Stipulation and Consent Order and any violation of this Order may result in disciplinary action.

ORDER

Based upon the above stipulation, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

- A. Respondent shall pay a **MONETARY CIVIL PENALTY** of \$800.00 within 90 days of entry of this Order.
- B. This Pre-Charge Stipulation and Consent Order is a matter of public record and may be reported to other licensing authorities as provided in 3 V.S.A. §129(a).
- C. This Pre-Charge Stipulation and Consent Order does not constitute a finding of unprofessional conduct.
- D. This Pre-Charge Stipulation and Consent Order will remain part of Respondent's licensing file and may be considered relative to any future disciplinary matter.
