STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER

STIPULATION

NOW COME the State of Vermont, through Attorney General William H. Sorrell, and Respondent Robert C. Larson, who stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The Board of Chiropractic Examination & Registration (Board) has jurisdiction to investigate and adjudicate allegations of unprofessional conduct, and approve consent orders pursuant to 3 V.S.A. §§129 and 129a, and 26 V.S.A. §541.
2. Respondent, Robert C. Larson, of Pittsford, Vermont, is a chiropractor holding license number 6-0735 issued by the State of Vermont.
3. Respondent admits he applied for relicensure in September of 1996. In that application he certified that he was "in good standing with respect to or in full compliance with a plan to pay any and all taxes due the State of Vermont as of the date of this application.
4. Respondent admits that at the time signed this application he was not in good standing or in compliance with a plan to pay any and all taxes due the State of Vermont.
5. Respondent admits the conclusions of unprofessional conduct as set forth below in the Board's Order.



6. Respondent understands that the Board must review and accept the terms of the Consent Order. If the Board rejects any portion, the entire Stipulation and Consent Order shall be null and void.
7. Respondent has read and reviewed this entire document and agrees that it contains the entire agreement between the parties.
8. Respondent voluntarily enters this agreement after the opportunity to consult with legal counsel and is not being coerced by anyone into signing this Stipulation and Consent Order.
9. Respondent voluntarily waives his right to charges and a contested hearing before the Board.
10. Respondent agrees that the order set forth below may be entered by the Board.

ORDER

Based on the stipulation above it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

- A. By engaging in the conduct described in paragraphs 2 through 4 above, Respondent has engaged in unprofessional conduct pursuant to 3V.S.A. §129a (a)(1).
- B. Respondent Robert C. Larson is hereby **reprimanded**.
- C. This Stipulation and Consent Order is a matter of public record and may be reported to other licensing authorities as provided in 3 V.S.A. §129(a)(7).
- D. This Stipulation and Consent Order will remain part of Respondent's licensing file and may be used for purposes of determining sanctions in any future disciplinary matter.
