STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER

STIPULATION

NOW COME the State of Vermont, by and through Prosecuting Attorney Jennifer B. Colin, and Respondent Deanna L. Willey, also known as Deanna L. Boucher, who hereby stipulate and Agree as follows:

Board Authority

1. The Vermont State Board of Dental Examiners (the "Board") has jurisdiction to investigate and adjudicate allegations of unprofessional conduct committed by dentists, dental hygienists, and dental assistants pursuant to 3 V.S.A. §§129, 129a; 26 V.S.A. Chapter 12; the Administrative Rules of the Board of Dental Examiners ("ARBDE"); and the Rules of the Office of Professional Regulation ("OPR").

Stipulated Facts

2. Deanna L. Willey, also known as Deanna L. Boucher, ("Respondent") of Barre, Vermont is licensed by the State of Vermont as a Registered Traditional Dental Assistant under license number 014.0001352. This license was first issued November 1, 1991 and expires September 30, 2019.
3. On October 29, 2018, Respondent filed an on-line Renewal/Reinstatement Application ("Renewal Application") with OPR for her Registered Traditional Dental Assistant license, which had expired on September 30, 2015.
4. On the Renewal Application, Respondent answered "Yes" to the question: "Have you been practicing in Vermont since your license expired?"
5. On the Renewal Application, Respondent stated "Name change and change of address. George and Koch Dental is where I work. There was a mistake and my renewal was not submitted."
6. Vermont law requires a dental assistant to be registered. 26 V.S.A. §641.

7. Respondent practiced as a dental assistant in Vermont for over three years without the required license.

Violation One: 3 V.S.A. §127. Unauthorized practice.

8. Paragraphs 2 through 7 above are incorporated herein.
9. Paragraphs 2 through 7 above demonstrate that Respondent practiced as a dental assistant in Vermont for over four years while not properly registered with OPR.
10. The act(s), omission(s), and/or circumstance(s) described above constitute grounds for a civil penalty because the Respondent has engaged in unauthorized practice of a regulated profession in violation of 3 V.S.A. §127.

Understandings

11. Respondent understands that the Board must review and accept the terms of the Consent Order. If the Board rejects any portion, the entire Stipulation and Consent Order shall be null and void.
12. This Stipulation and Consent Order is intended to resolve all matters related to Docket No. 2019-88. This Stipulation and Consent Order is not a finding of unprofessional conduct.
13. Respondent specifically waives any claims that any disclosures made to the full Board during its review of this agreement have prejudiced Respondent's rights to a fair and impartial hearing in future hearings if this agreement is not accepted by the Board.
14. Respondent has read and reviewed this entire document and agrees that it contains the entire agreement between the parties.
15. Respondent is not under the influence of any drugs or alcohol at the time of signature of this Stipulation and Consent Order.
16. Respondent voluntarily enters into this agreement after the opportunity to consult with legal counsel and is not being coerced by anyone into signing this Stipulation and Consent Order.
17. Respondent voluntarily waives the right to a contested hearing before the Board and waives any right to appeal from this Stipulation and Consent Order.
18. Respondent agrees that the Order set forth below may be entered by the Board.

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ORDER

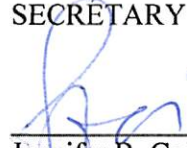
Based on the Stipulation above, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

- A. The Board of Dental Examiners hereby imposes a **MONETAR CIVIL PENALTY IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$250.00)**. This penalty shall be paid within sixty (60) days of the date of entry of this Order.
- B. This Stipulation and Consent Order is a matter of public record and may be reported to other licensing authorities as provided in 3 V.S.A. §129(a).
- C. This Stipulation and Consent Order will remain part of Respondent's licensing file and may be used for purposes of determining sanctions in any future unlicensed practice or disciplinary matter.

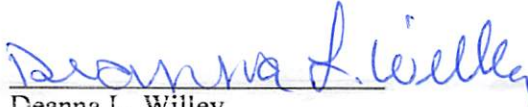
