STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER

STIPULATION

NOW COME the State of Vermont through its Attorney General, William H. Sorrell, and Christine F. Reno, who stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The Vermont Board of Dental Examiners ("Board") has jurisdiction to investigate and adjudicate allegations of unprofessional conduct committed by dental assistants pursuant to 3 V.S.A. §§129, 129a and 814; 26 V.S.A. §§862 to 867; the Administrative Rules of the Board and of the Office of Professional Regulation.
2. Respondent Christine F. Reno, of Milton, Vermont, is a licensed practical nurse, holding license number 25-6720, originally issued by the State of Vermont on about October 16, 1991 (which is currently active). Further, this license was reprimanded pursuant to a Stipulation and Consent Order entered by the Vermont Board of Nursing on about February 14, 2001 (Docket No.: NU10-0800, attached and incorporated).
3. Respondent admits that on or about November 8, 2001, she prepared, signed and/or filed an Application For Registration as a Dental Assistant, with the Vermont Secretary of State, Office of Professional Regulation (thus, is both a "Respondent" and an "Applicant").

4. Respondent admits that on the above application, she indicated, "No" when asked, "Has any state or federal licensing authority restricted, suspended, revoked, or taken any other disciplinary action against a license, certificate, or registration that you hold or held in any profession or occupation?" The application continued, "If the answer is 'yes', provide a copy of the order or official notification of the Board action." though no such documentation was provided.
5. Respondent admits the conclusions of unprofessional conduct as set forth below in the Board's Order.
6. Respondent agrees that the Board may enter the Order set forth below.
7. Respondent understands that the Board must review and accept the terms of this Stipulation and Consent Order. If the Board rejects any portion, the entire Stipulation and Consent Order shall be null and void.
8. Respondent waives any notification period and agrees to have this document reviewed by the Board during the next available meeting. Respondent specifically waives any claims that any disclosures made to the full Board during its review of this agreement have prejudiced her rights to a fair and impartial hearing in future hearings if this agreement is not accepted by the Board.
9. Respondent is not under the influence of any drugs or alcohol at the time she signs this Stipulation and Consent Order.
10. Respondent waives her right to a contested hearing before the Board on any pending charges.
11. Respondent has read and reviewed this entire document and agrees it contains the entire agreement between the parties.

12. Respondent voluntarily enters this agreement after the opportunity to consult with legal counsel and is not being coerced by anyone into signing this agreement.

ORDER

Based on the stipulations above it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

A. The Vermont Board of Dental Examiners concludes that the above acts, omissions and/or circumstances, constitute unprofessional conduct and violate 3 V.S.A. §129a(a)(1) (fraudulent or deceptive procurement or use of a license).

B. Respondent's application for registration is granted, and further, Respondent is **REPRIMANDED**.

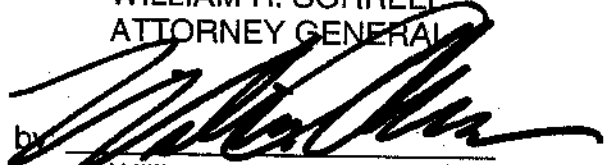
C. This Stipulation and Consent Order is a matter of public record and may be reported to other licensing authorities as provided in 3 V.S.A. §129(a)(7).

STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER

STIPULATION

1. The Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to investigate complaints of unprofessional conduct and to conduct hearings pursuant to 3 V.S.A. §129, and 26 V.S.A. §§1574, 1582.
2. Respondent is a licensed practical nurse licensed by the State of Vermont holding license number 25-06720.
3. At all times relevant to this Specification of Charges, Respondent was employed by Fletcher Allen Health Care of Burlington, Vermont.
4. Respondent admits that on or about April 14, 2000, she accessed by computer the medical records of another person, L.C. At the time she did so, there was no professional reason for her to do so. L.C was not her patient nor was Respondent in any way assigned to her care.
5. Respondent admits that on or about June 21, 2000, Respondent again accessed by computer the medical records of another person, L.C. At the time she did so, there was no professional reason for her to do so. L.C was not her patient nor was Respondent in any way assigned to her care.
6. Respondent admits she admitted to Investigator Ron west that she had told a third person about seeing L.C. at Fletcher Allen Health Care.

7. Respondent understands that the Board must review and accept the terms of this agreement. If the Board rejects any portion, the entire agreement shall be null and void.

8. Respondent has read and reviewed this entire document and agrees that it contains the entire agreement between the parties.

9. Respondent is not under the influence of any drugs or alcohol at the time she signs this agreement.

10. Respondent voluntarily enters this agreement after the opportunity to consult with legal counsel and is not being coerced by anyone into signing it.

11. Respondent agrees that the order set forth below may be entered by the Board.

ORDER

Based on the stipulation above it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

A. The Board finds that by the actions described in paragraphs 4 through 6 Respondent has committed unprofessional conduct pursuant to 26 V.S.A. §1582(a)(3)(unable to practice nursing competently by reason of any cause) and Vermont Nursing Board Rule IV.B. (2)(B), since these actions fail to conform to the essential standards of acceptable and prevailing nursing practice.

B. The Board hereby **reprimands** the license of Christine Faith Reno.

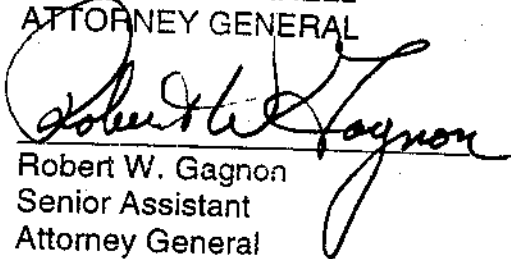

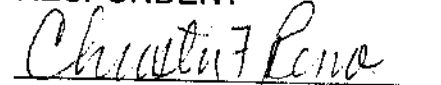

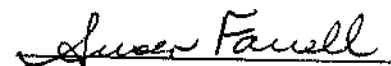
