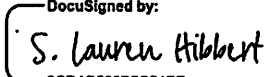

RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO REMOVE CONDITIONS ON LICENSE

NOW COMES the Respondent, KAREN TENDRUP, by her attorneys, Brady / Donahue, and hereby files the following Petition to Remove Conditions on License. In support hereof, Respondent states as follows.

Pursuant to the *Stipulation and Consent Order* approved by the Board on August 8, 20202, Respondent undertook the completion of two required courses to the satisfaction of the assigned Case Manager, Kristin Donnelly. Accordingly, Respondent is authorized to petition the Board to remove "any and all conditions" on her nursing license.
