STIPULATION TO MODIFY CONDITIONS

NOW COME the State of Vermont, by State Prosecuting Attorney Gabriel M. Gilman, and the respondent, Brenda Bean, RN ("Respondent"), who stipulate and agree as follows:

1. Respondent's license is conditioned pursuant to this Board's Order entered November 6, 2012 in Docket No. 2010-530.
2. Respondent has complied fully with the Order to date. Required employer reports and references have been uniformly positive. Owing to changes in Respondent's employment circumstances and opportunities, the parties agree that it would be equitable to modify the existing Order in the manner proposed below.
3. The State is authorized to represent that the investigative team assigned to the underlying case has evaluated Respondent's request, together with supporting documentation, and supports the proposed modification.

ORDER

The Board of Nursing hereby MODIFIES these conditions enumerated in the Board's Order of November 6, 2012, as follows:

A. Condition (3), captioned *Employment Restriction*, is amended such that the sentence reading, "Respondent shall practice nursing only in a physician's-office setting." is STRICKEN.

B. A new Condition (12) is ADDED to the Order, as follows:

(12) Reports from Employers/Program Director.

Within one (1) month of entry of this Order or the commencement of nursing employment, and monthly thereafter, Respondent shall cause every nursing employer the Respondent has worked for during the month to submit to the Board an evaluation of Respondent's work performance and attendance during that month. These reports shall be submitted in writing on forms issued by the Board. All employer reports

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shall indicate satisfactory performance (i.e., consistently meeting all standards of nursing practice).

In the event the Respondent is attending a nursing program, Respondent shall cause the Program Director to submit to the Board, on a monthly basis, a written evaluation of her performance and attendance. These reports shall be submitted in writing on forms issued by the Board. All nursing program reports shall indicate satisfactory performance (i.e., consistently meeting all standards of nursing practice).
