STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER

STIPULATION

NOW COME the State of Vermont, by and through State Prosecuting Attorney BetsyAnn Wrask, and the Respondent, Bonnie-Lynn Breer, RN, who stipulate and agree as follows:

Board Authority

1. The Vermont State Board of Nursing (the "Board") has authority to issue warnings or reprimands; suspend, revoke, limit, or condition current licenses; or prevent the renewal of lapsed licenses if, after disciplinary hearing, the Board finds that the Respondent has engaged in unprofessional conduct. 3 V.S.A. § 129(a); 3 V.S.A. § 129a; 3 V.S.A. § 814(d); 26 V.S.A. § 1582; the Administrative Rules of the Board of Nursing (the "ARBN"); and the Rules of the Office of Professional Regulation.

Statement of Facts

2. Bonnie-Lynn Breer (the "Respondent") of Marshfield, Vermont is licensed by the State of Vermont as a Registered Nurse under license number 026.0021115. This license was originally issued on or about July 8, 1993 and is currently set to expire on or about March 31, 2011. Respondent has also been licensed by the State of Vermont as a Licensed Practical Nurse under license number 025.0005851. Respondent's LPN license was originally issued on or about November 26, 1985 and expired on or about January 31, 1994.
3. On or about September 3, 2008, Respondent was convicted of Careless or Negligent Vehicle Operation in Washington District Court under docket number 390-4-08 Wncr.
4. On or about February 14, 2009 in a Registered Nurse Renewal Application, Respondent answered "No" to the question, "Since you were originally licensed or since you completed your last renewal application, have you been convicted of a crime other than a minor traffic violation?"

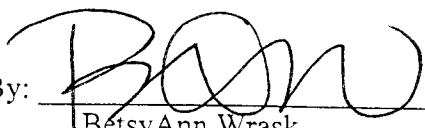

- A. The Board of Nursing hereby **REPRIMANDS** Respondent's registered nursing license and imposes an **ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150)** on the Respondent. This administrative penalty is to be paid within sixty (60) days of the date of entry of this Order.
- B. Notwithstanding any provision above, the Respondent must continue to meet all Nursing Board requirements for maintaining a license, license renewal and license reinstatement.
- C. This Stipulation and Consent Order is a matter of public record and may be reported to other licensing authorities as provided in 3 V.S.A. § 129(a).
- D. This Stipulation and Consent Order will remain part of Respondent's licensing file and may be used for purposes of determining sanctions in any future disciplinary matter.

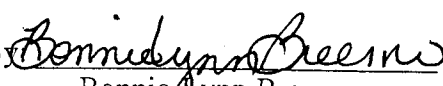

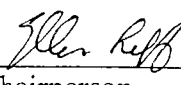
