STIPULATION FOR DISMISSAL

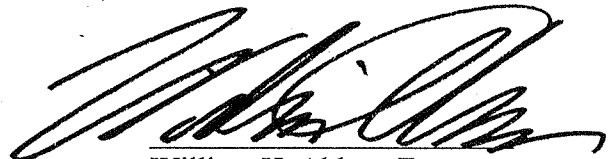

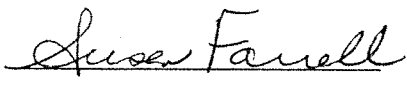

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SUMMARY SUSPENSION ORDER

On November 5, 2001, this case came before the Board of Nursing for a hearing on the State's request for summary suspension.

Based upon the evidence presented by the parties, the Board finds that the allegations in the request for summary suspension have been established to the necessary degree. Therefore, the Board finds that the public health, safety, or welfare imperatively require emergency action against the Respondent's license.

Pursuant to 3 V.S.A. § 814(c), Respondent Jo Anna Buik's nursing licenses are SUMMARILY SUSPENDED until a hearing on charges has been held and determined, or other resolution of this case.
