STIPULATION

NOW COMES the State of Vermont, through its Attorney General, William H. Sorrell, and Respondent Trudy DeFlorio, who stipulate and agree as follows:

1. The Vermont Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to investigate and adjudicate allegations of unprofessional conduct committed by nurses pursuant to 3 V.S.A. §§129, 129a; 26 V.S.A. §§1574, and 1582; the Board of Nursing Rules and the Office of Professional Regulation's Rules.
2. The State of Vermont and Respondent Trudy DeFlorio, by their attorneys, *with prejudice (Tom)* Stipulate and Agree that this action is dismissed, and the Board may enter the following Order.

Based on the stipulation above it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

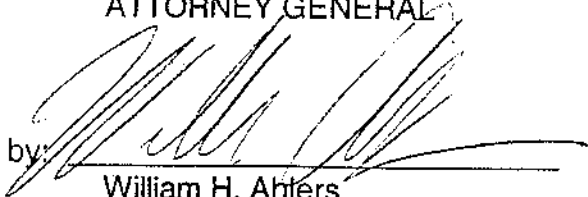
- A. The Specification of Charges dated May 31, 2000 are dismissed with prejudice and Respondent is exonerated of the charges.

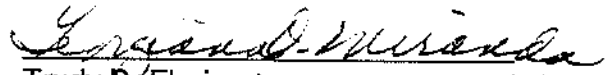
