Order to Modify Conditions

On October 10, 2016, the Vermont Board of Nursing considered David G. Dumas' request for Modification to his Board Order effective May 12, 2015. The Investigative Team found that David G. Dumas has satisfied all four pre-requisites for removal of the prohibition of administration of controlled drugs. The pre-requisites include employment as a nurse for six months for at least forty hours every two weeks, a letter of support from the treating professional, a letter of support from the employer, and a description of the medication documentation and inventory control procedures in place at the place of employment. The State does not object to removal of this condition.

Order:

The Board hereby removes the condition A. 11. Administration of Medications from David G. Dumas' RN license. All other conditions previously imposed in this matter remain in effect.
