ORDER APPROVING REMOVAL OF LICENSE CONDITIONS

This matter was considered on March 9, 2015. The Respondent participated by telephone. The State was represented by S. Lauren Hibbert, Esq. The Petitioner was licensed in Vermont as an LPN and was disciplined by Order of the Board on October 29, 2007. Her LPN license was conditioned for a period of one year. She left the nursing field in December of 2007 and did not complete the one year period of conditions.

The Petitioner entered a two-year nursing program and is expected to graduate in May of 2015. She has petitioned the Board to remove the conditions upon her LPN license. The Board, after consideration of the circumstances, has decided to remove the conditions upon the Petitioner's LPN license. In so doing, the Board is not rescinding or modifying the findings of the 2007 Board Order or the conclusion of that order that the Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct

APPEAL RIGHTS

This is a final administrative determination by the Vermont Board of Nursing.

A party aggrieved by a final decision of a board may appeal this decision by filing a written Notice of Appeal with the Director of the Office of Professional Regulation, Vermont Secretary of State, 89 Main Street, Fl. 3, Montpelier, VT 05620-3402 within 30 days of the entry of this order.

If an appeal is filed, the Director of the Office of Professional Regulation shall assign the case to an appellate officer. The review shall be conducted on the basis of the record created before the board. In cases of alleged irregularities in procedure before the board, not shown in the record, proof on that issue may be taken by the appellate officer. 3 V.S.A. §§ 129(d) and 130a.
