FUNERAL SERVICE Application Instructions for Limited Services Establishment

26 V.S.A. § 1252(g)

Limited services shall be overseen by a licensed funeral director who is employed by the limited service establishment. Each limited-service arrangement shall include a mandatory written disclosure providing notice to the purchaser that limited services do not include embalming, public viewings, gatherings, memorials, funerals, or related ceremonies.

LICENSE: Applicants must submit the following:

- Submit an online application and pay the non-refundable application fee. Applications are found
 within the online licensing system at:

- 2. Upload with your application permits showing the building to be used (a) has a water supply and wastewater disposal as required by the Agency of Natural Resources. Submit copies of all applications and/or state permits issued for the establishment to operate in the state.
- 3. Upload with your application documentation of approval from the State Fire Marshal
- 4. Identify the licensed funeral director to be responsible for the Limited Services Establishment.
- 5. Pass an Inspection by the Office
- 6. Upload with your application a description of the type of structure and equipment to be used in the operation of this crematory.
- 7. Submit a copy of the Registration of the Limited Services Establishments name and active status, obtained from the Corporations Division, Office of the Secretary of State. This information can be obtained here: https://bizfilings.vermont.gov/online/BusinessInguire/

NOTE: Any change of address or other contract information, by an applicant or licensee, <u>must</u> be forwarded to this office no later than thirty (30) days after change occurs.
