

Vermont Board of Nursing Practice Remediation Program

The purpose of the Practice Remediation Program is to improve public protection by facilitating timely remediation for nurse and nursing assistant practice errors that are not serious enough to require formal and public discipline. Participation in the program is voluntary. Each participant enters into a contract with the Board of Nursing to complete online education courses and/or a period of supervised practice. The education and/or supervision are designed to address the practice issue of concern and assure that the participant is able to practice safely. As long as the participant is in compliance with the contract, there is no public disclosure of participation and no public conditions on the participant's license.
