## **Residential Contractors** Application Instructions

## **REGISTRATION:**

- 1. Log in to your online account and select "apply for license".
- 2. Complete the online application and pay the non-refundable application fee.
- 3. Within the application, indicate whether you are registering as an INDIVIDUAL or a BUSINESS.
  - **Individual registrations** are for residential contractors who are self-employed and do not have any employees.
  - **Business registrations** are for contractors who have employees working for them. Employees of a registered business do not need to register; they will be covered under the business registration.
- Individuals and Businesses must provide documentation of name registered with Corporations and show active status. This is available from the Corporations Division at <a href="https://bizfilings.vermont.gov/online/BusinessInquire/">https://bizfilings.vermont.gov/online/BusinessInquire/</a>
  (Note that OPR will accept a screenshot or PDF version of your business screen uploaded as long as the document is readable)
  - a. Click the link
  - b. Enter your business name or Business ID. Click search
  - c. Select your business from the list. Ensure your status is active
  - d. Take a screenshot or print the page
  - e. Upload to your OPR application
- 5. Upload a copy of your Insurance Certificate. A minimum liability insurance coverage in the amount of \$1,000.000.00 per occurrence and \$2,000.000.00 aggregate.
- 6. Attest to use of Written contract prior to receiving a deposit or commencing residential construction work if the estimated value of the labor and materials exceeds \$10,000.00.
- 7. If applicable, list other states where you are licensed.

NOTE: Any change of address or other contact information, by an applicant or licensee, <u>must</u> be forwarded to this office no later than thirty (30) days after change occurs.
