# SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST

### **Application Instructions**

### LICENSURE BY EXAMINATION:

- 1. Complete online application and pay the nonrefundable application Fee; and
- 2. Upload proof of ASHA Certification

## LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT:

To qualify to be licensed, an applicant must be licensed or certified in good standing in another jurisdiction in which the standards and qualifications required for regulation in that jurisdiction are substantially equivalent to Vermont's.

- 1. Complete online application and pay the nonrefundable application Fee;
- 2. Verification of Licensure form. Provide verification of your original state of licensure as well as the license from your most recent state of employment; and
- 3. Upload proof of ASHA Certification

### FAST TRACK ENDORSEMENT:

To qualify to be licensed, an applicant must be actively licensed or certified in good standing in another jurisdiction for <u>three or more years</u> preceding this application.

- 1. Complete Application and pay Application Fee (Non-Refundable Processing fee);
- 2. Verification of Licensure form. Provide verification of your most current state of licensure.

Verification must show proof of continuous licensure in good standing for 3 years preceding the date of this application; and

3. If applicable, complete and upload the specific VT State Jurisprudence exam answer sheet.

#### Note for Speech-Language Pathologist Educators

A speech-language pathologist employed in a school as an educator must, in addition to holding an speech-language pathologist license from OPR, hold an endorsement from the Agency of Education (AOE) and must retain and renew that endorsement with AOE as required by law. Please contact AOE directly with questions about the SLP educator endorsement.

#### **PROVISIONAL LICENSURE BY REGISTRATION:**

- 1. Complete online application and pay the nonrefundable application fee
- 2. Provide in your online application the name and license number of your supervisor
- 3. Contact your school where you obtained your Master's degree to have them send the office official transcripts of your degree

NOTE: Any change of address or other contract information, by an applicant or licensee, <u>must</u> be forwarded to this office no later than thirty (30) days after change occurs.
