

## **Preliminary Assessment of Mass Valuation Appraisal as a Licensed Profession in Vermont**

The Office of Professional Regulation (OPR) is performing a preliminary assessment of mass valuation appraisal (MVA) becoming a licensed profession in Vermont. MVA services are currently regulated by the Department of Taxes. During this assessment process, OPR will evaluate whether MVA services meet the criteria for regulation by OPR as set forth in [26 V.S.A. Chapter 57](#).

OPR's goal is to identify all relevant issues, understand all stakeholder perspectives, and perform an analysis faithful to the statutory criteria. To best understand the process, participants are strongly encouraged to review the Chapter 57 criteria and standards.
