

Preliminary Assessment of Speech-Language Pathology Assistants as a Licensed Profession in Vermont

The Office of Professional Regulation (OPR) is performing a preliminary assessment of speech-language pathology assistants (SLPA) becoming a licensed profession in Vermont.

During this review process, OPR will evaluate whether the services provided by SLPA meet the criteria for regulation as set forth in [26 V.S.A. Chapter 57](#).

OPR's goal is to identify all relevant issues, understand all stakeholder perspectives, and perform an analysis faithful to the statutory criteria. To best understand the process, participants are strongly encouraged to review the Chapter 57 criteria and standards.
